


Fire Escape Plan

1. Use the grid to draw a floor plan of your home. Use a separate page for each floor.
2. Designate two routes out of each room using doors or windows. Mark the locations of smoke alarms with **SA**.
3. Choose a meeting place outside your home and note it on the plan.
4. Post your fire escape plan where everyone can see it. Make sure anyone staying overnight is familiar with the plan.
5. Practice using the escape plan with your family at least twice per year.
